Rationale

The centralization of all Vulnerable Sector Checks will be conducted by the Ontario Hockey Federation (OHF) for all Team Officials and Team Personnel for the 2024-2025 season to:

- ensure all screening is being done.
- reduce number of screenings where individuals are changing and/or participating in multiple Associations.
- provide a safe hockey environment.

Screening of all On-Ice Officials has been in place the past number of years. Minor Hockey Associations will continue to screen Staff and Board members that are not involved in on-ice programming.

The following individuals who are associated with the OHF, Members, hockey leagues, hockey Clubs and/or Associations must adhere to the OHF Screening Policy can be found online and submit to the Ontario Hockey Federation:

- Team officials (including but not limited to head coaches, assistant coaches, trainers, managers and at large team officials);
- On-ice officials; and
- Anyone else, included but not limited to on-ice volunteer, skills coaches, third party skills coaches and dressing room supervisors, through their duties on behalf of the OHF, a Member, a hockey Club or Association.

The Vulnerable Sector Checks Process for Coaches/Volunteers

- 1. Get your documents organized and determine where you need to go to get a Vulnerable Sector Check completed (a formal letter may be required):
 - OHF Letter Requesting Vulnerable Sector Check (contained in this package or can be found on OHF webpage).
- 2. Once ready, including the approved VSC from your local police service, begin the Screening Submission
 - Locate your HCR # and register for the OHF Screening Process
 - Once registered, click continue
 - Complete the form and upload your documents (read all instructions to ensure complete accuracy)

Required Documents

Before entering the OHF Screening Submission Portal, please ensure you have the following information to complete the Vulnerable Sector Check:

- 1. Hockey Canada Registry (HCR) Number; AND
- 2. Vulnerable Sector Check (a receipt for the Vulnerable Sector Check to show it's in progress can be uploaded).

Once your check has been submitted, you will receive an email that it will be reviewed within 3 business days. Check your HCR account for updates.

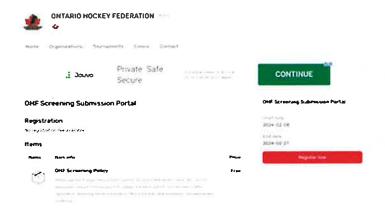
PLEASE NOTE:

- All documents must all be in PDF format to be accepted.
- Should your returned Vulnerable Sector Check from your police service be password protected, save the PDF to remove the password encryption. Alternatively, you can print the Check and scan as a PDF to upload.
- For the 2024-25 season, the OHF will be accepting copies of a Vulnerable Sector Check from 2022-23 OR 2023-24 AND the completed online OHF Screening Declaration (this document can be found online at the OHF website). A copy has been included in this package as well however these must be completed online for submission.
- There are requirements for registered players that require documentation to show proof of residence and birth certificate. This is NOT a requirement for Coaches or Officials.

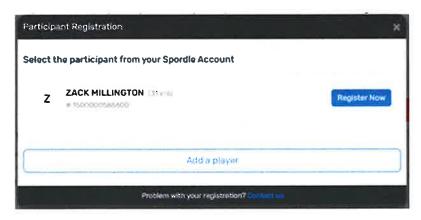

VSC Frequently Asked Questions

General

Who is this for?

Anyone who, through their duties on behalf of the OHF, a Member, Senior, Junior, Minor and Female Hockey (Associations, Teams, Clubs) work with children (included but not limited to on-ice volunteer, skills coaches, third party skills coaches and dressing room supervisors).

How do we manage our organization's staff and board members?

All Members and Senior, Junior, Minor and Female Hockey (Associations, Teams, Clubs) will continue to screen Staff and Board members that are not involved in on-ice programming.

What is the minimum age to complete the screening?

18. Under the age of 18, that individual will still need to take the courses required to be on the bench.

When does this start?

Effective April 1, 2024, for the for the 2024-2025 hockey season. The OHF will accept copies of a VSC from the 2022-23 or 2023-24 season. Individuals would be required to get a new VSC if they have one one prior to these seasons.

 Do I still need to submit my VSC if I have previously submitted it to my local association?

Yes, as of April 1, 2024, all screenings must be submitted to the OHF. The OHF would need to validate any previous screening done by your local association. Individuals CAN submit Vulnerable Sector Checks completed in 2022, 2023, or 2024 for the upcoming 2024-25 season.

What offences would disqualify an individual?

The details are in the OHF Screening Policy

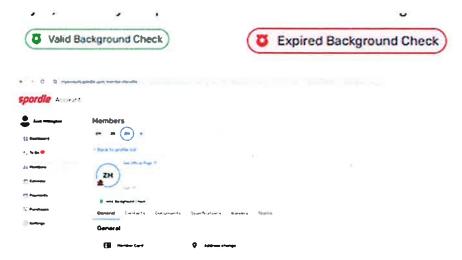
What is the turnaround time?

1-3 business days.

• Will you decline an application if there are errors, or will you email the individual with instructions on what to rectify?

Yes, approved or declined, the OHF will follow up.

 Will HCR profiles show that an individual has submitted their VSC within the OHF portal and that it is pending? No, the HCR profile will not show whether their screening is within the OHF portal and is pending. The HCR will be updated once a decision is made - green for valid and red for expired.



If someone disagrees with a decision, is there an appeal process or further review?

Yes, there is an appeal process.

How does an Association or the individual know the process is complete?

The Association will need to check an individual's HCR profile once the process is complete.

Documents

Can individuals use their workplace police checks if it is a vulnerable sector one?

No, individual checks must be done for each organization or workplace.

Does the Association or OHF provide a letter for VSC?

Coach and Official Eligibility

• We have a Third Party that comes in for Player Evaluations. Would everyone need to do a screening before getting on the ice?

Anyone who, through their duties on behalf of the OHF, a Member, Senior, Junior, Minor and Female Hockey (Associations, Teams, Clubs) work with children (included but not limited to on-ice volunteer, skills coaches, third party skills coaches and dressing room supervisors).

• If a team hires a Third-Party Instructor without the Association's knowledge, how do we know that they have been screened? Please make your teams aware of the process that Third-Party Instructors are properly screened.

How will registrars know if an individual has been approved?

Associations will be able to see on an individual's HCR profile whether their VSC or Declaration has been approved.

Who is uploading the past years' checks?

Coaches still need to complete the <u>Declaration</u> with the process. For the 2024-25 season, the OHF will accept copies of a VSC from the 2022-23 or 2023-24 season. Individuals will need to get a new VSC if they completed one prior to these seasons.

Will the OHF contact the organization if they reject a volunteer (for whatever reason)?

We will let the Individual and the Association know of the rejection.

Someone requests a VSC, and they are flagged for fingerprints with RCMP. The process could take up to three months. Can individuals still help during that time?

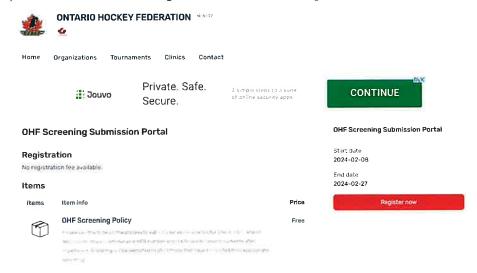
Yes, they can submit a receipt of the Vulnerable Sector Check AND complete the online OHF Declaration in the meantime.

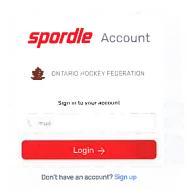
OHF Screening Submission Process – New Coach or Official without a Spordle/HCR account.

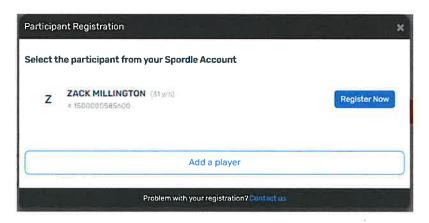
Step 2: On the HCR 'OHF Screening Submission Portal' click 'Register Now'



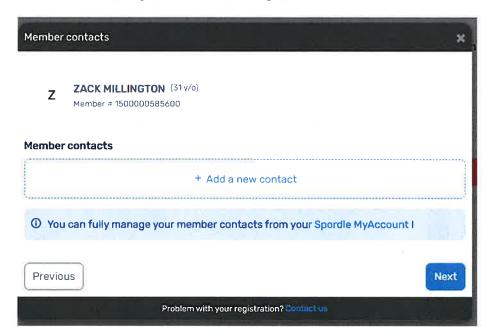
Step 3: You will need to create an HCR/Spordle Account. Click 'Sign up' to create your profile.



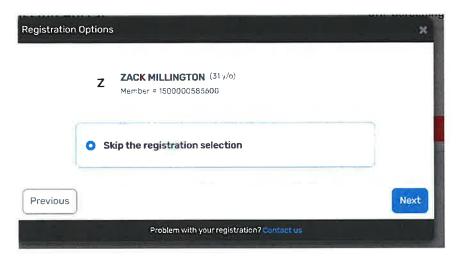
- Step 4: Enter your email to sign up. Complete all required information to create your profile.

- Step 6: Select the participant from your Spordle Account and click 'register now'.



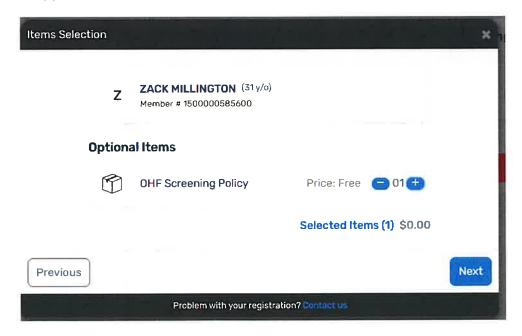

How to Link your Spordle and HCR account

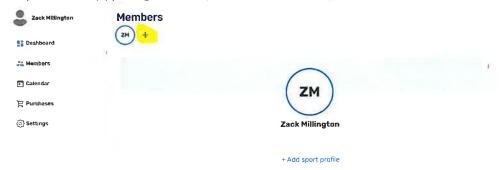
Step 1: Sign in with Spordle Account at https://myaccount.spordle.com/dashboard



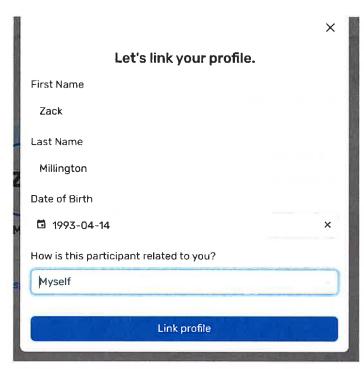
Step 2: In your Spordle Account, click 'Members' on the left hand side of the page.



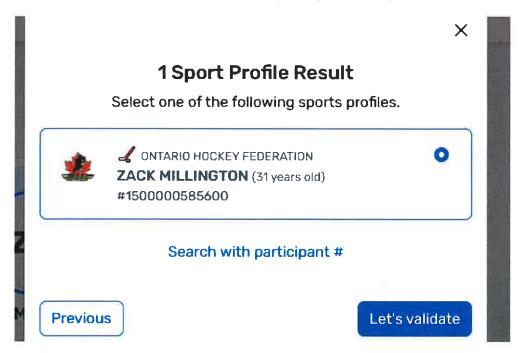
Step 3: Click the (+) plus sign on the top left to 'Link a Member'.
